Directive 2011/65/EU, including amendment Directive (EU) 2015/863 (RoHS)

Zivid's products comply with Directive 2011/65/EU, including amendment Directive (EU) 2015/863 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS Directive).

The RoHS Directive restricts the contents of these 10 hazardous substances:

Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Bis (2-ethylhexyl phthalate (DEHP)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Di isobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)

Zivid declares that the following products do not contain any of the listed substances above the specified limits, hence complying to the RoHS directive:
